Interested filmmakers can submit their films online through Film Freeway, an online platform that film festivals use to manage the submissions and judging process.

Hoosier Films co-founder and CEO Meredith McGriff says "We're committed to keeping the festival safe and accessible to a broad audience, so we will definitely be offering passholders online screening options this coming spring. Due to the pandemic, our plans for in-person events at the 2021 festival are only tentative at this time. We'll make final decisions and share more specifics in early 2021."

This new film festival made its debut during the pandemic in 2020, and successfully shifted to an online platform when in-person events were unadvisable. The first festival included 3 feature films and 37 short films. Filmmakers hailed from all over the state of Indiana, and the films covered a range of genres, including comedy, drama, sci-fi, horror, and more.

Hoosier Films is a multi-platform distribution company exclusive to Indiana-based filmmakers. Distribution through Hoosier Films is neither required nor contingent upon submission to the festival.
