Hoosier Films Annual Festival seeks submissions for 2022

The festival is open to any films with strong Indiana connections, including films with central cast and crew from the state, or documentaries with an exclusively Indiana-based topic. Interested filmmakers can submit their films online through Film Freeway, an online platform that film festivals use to manage the submissions and judging process.

The Hoosier Films Annual Festival made its debut during the pandemic in 2020, and shifted to an online platform when in-person events were unadvisable. It remained online for a second year in 2021. Hoosier Films co-founder and CEO Meredith McGriff says "It seems likely we'll be able to finally have an inperson event in 2022, but those plans are just tentative at this time. We're committed to keeping the festival safe and accessible to a broad audience, so we plan to continue offering online screening options for the festival this coming spring."

Hoosier Films is a multi-platform distribution company exclusive to Indiana-based filmmakers. Distribution through Hoosier Films is neither required nor contingent upon submission to the festival.
